This fall, each region will elect a new slate of officers. CAYSA is a dual member chapter of the American Correctional Association. Your CAYSA membership entitles you to all the benefits of both organizations. Your region is determined by the county in which you live or work. As a result, CAYSA regions provide a forum for discussion of local, regional needs and problems and to gain statewide recognition and representation.

Region I (Western)

Allegany, Cattaraugus, Chautauqua, Erie, Genesee, Livingston, Monroe, Niagara, Ontario, Orleans, Steuben, Wyoming and Yates.

Region II (North Central)

Clinton, Essex, Franklin, Hamilton, Jefferson, Lewis and St. Lawrence.

Region III (South Central)

Albany, Columbia, Fulton, Greene, Montgomery, Rensselaer, Saratoga, Schenectady, Schoharie, Warren and Washington.

Region IV (Southern) Dutchess, Orange, Putnam, Rockland, Ulster, Sullivan and Westchester.

Region V (**Metropolitan**) Kings, Queens, Bronx, New York, Richmond, Nassau and Suffolk.

Region VI (Central) Tioga, Broome, Delaware, Otsego, Chenango, Cortland, Tompkins, Cayuga, Onondaga, Madison, Oneida, Oswego, Herkimer, Seneca, Schuyler, Chemung and Wayne.

Regional Vice President	the chief elected officer of the region and its representative to the
	State Executive Board; presides at and attends all meetings;
	oversees regional activities; submits regional report to executive
	board; appoints chairs.

Assistant Vice President assists in all active operations; assumes role of VP in the event of absence or vacant seat.

Secretary maintains effective records; ensures meetings are efficient and organized; communications and correspondence.

Treasureroversees regions' financial condition. Duties include record all
receipts and expenditures; pay bills promptly and keep supporting
documents; make a financial report for regional VP to present at
each executive board meeting; maintain bank account and be one
of the signatories; prepare annual budget with regional BP.
